The Newark Valley Cross-Country program invites you to join us for the 40th **Annual Newark Valley / Bob Greene Cross-Country Invitational**, sponsored by the <u>Newark Valley Varsity Club</u>. The meet will be held on Friday afternoon/evening. The 3.1 mile (5K) Varsity and the 1.5 mile (2,420 meters) Junior High (Modified) courses are well-groomed and have wide avenues for running. The course layout permits extensive spectator viewing while virtually eliminating the need for spectators to cross the course to watch the runners. **We will accept a total of 25 Schools.**

When responding with your intention to enter (see below), please indicate an approximate number of runners in each race. Note that you don't have to decide whether you want to enter 7, 8, or 9 runners in the Varsity races until the entries are submitted to Milesplit. Once submitted though, no changes or substitutions. No Varsity team may enter the JV race. Modified entries must be 7th & 8th graders.

Please let us know if you are <u>planning on participating in this year's event by Friday, September 15th</u>. In addition to sending the 2nd page of this form to our AD, a quick reply email to me with your estimated numbers for each race really helps us with planning. Thanks!

All entries are to be submitted on Milesplit on or before Friday, September 29th by 8 PM.

Awards:

Individuals: All individual Varsity, JV and awards will be handed out in the finish chute.

Varsity boys and Varsity girls races: Medals to top 10; T-shirts for top 10; Ribbons for places 11-35 boys / 11-35 girls JV boys: Medals to top 5; T-shirts for top 10, Ribbons for places 6-35 boys Modified boys and Modified girls races: Top 10 T-Shirts, ribbons 1-35

Teams: Plaques presented at the conclusion of the meet

The top-scoring Large School (Classes A and B) and the top-scoring Small School (Classes C and D) will determine team champions for all races. The second highest-scoring Large school and Small school finishers will earn the Runners-Up championship plaques for all races:

Varsity Boys and Girls races: Large School Division and Small School Division Champions and Runners-Up JV Boys: Champions and Runners-Up

Modified Boys and Girls: Large School Division and Small School Division champions and Runners-Up

Fee: \$75 per race

\$20 per individual runner (Varsity, J.V., or Modified). Maximum amount \$200 per school.

- * Locker-room facilities are available in the High School. No Spikes may be worn in the building. <u>Use only the designated areas.</u>

 Any runner caught wandering the building will be disqualified with their entire team.
- * The Cardinal Booster Club will be operating the Concession Stand for your and the spectators' convenience.
- * The Running Club will be selling t-shirts.
