Rules:

Jewelry, uniform, and electronics rules are in effect and will be enforced. The Games Committee will be comprised of the head official and the Event Director. Any protests must be clearly written and explained before given to anyone on the Games Committee.

Concessions:

There will be a concessions booth that will feature a variety of snacks and refreshments.

Course Information: A well-marked course with open grass fields, wooded trails and varied terrain.

Team Drop-Off: Teams can be dropped off in the FLCC parking lot located near the start and finish line.

Bus Parking: After team drop off, please direct drivers to the parking lot east of drop off.

Packet Pick-Up: Coaches can pick up racing bibs order of event list, list of participating schools, starting line box assignments and course maps at a table located near team drop off.

Team Tents: Please set up tents behind the starting area. Please remind athletes to stay out of the ponds and away from the higher grass and viney trees as there may be poison ivy.

Spike Recommendation: Spikes are recommended. The course crosses pavement twice at the beginning and end of the race and once in the second mile.
