

## **Starpoint Team Challenge Information 2019**



Your team is invited to participate in the 11th annual Starpoint Team Challenge at 2:00 pm. on Saturday, May 4th, 2019 at Starpoint High School. This meet will have the same format as a typical individual competition, but team points will be awarded to finishers (2 athletes) with the best combined time, distance, or height. Traditional relays will be run with team points earned by 1 relay team.

**Meet Format:** The combined results of the two competitors will score for each individual event. Relays will be scored as they normally are with 1 relay team per school comprised of 4 runners. Tandems will then be ranked based on combined times, distance or height.

\*Our new scoreboard is compatible with the timing system, so times will be displayed instantly!\*

<u>Example</u>: Starpoint runner 1's time is 55.1 and Starpoint runner 2's time is 56.5. The combined time for the runners is 1.51.6. Starpoints' tandem will be ranked based on their combined total time. Ties will be broken by the better result of the top finisher of the tied teams.

**Team Scoring:** 10-8-6-4-2-1. Tied team finishers will be broken by the team with the most first-place finishes over-all.

**Awards:** Medals to the top tandem and relays in each event. Ribbons will be awarded to 2nd thru 6th place. Team awards to the top 2 boys and girls teams. Awards will be given to coaches at the conclusion of the meet.

\*\*Athletes that break existing meet records will be awarded a meet record holder T-shirt! \*\*

**Miscellaneous Information**: The track is an all-weather surface. <u>1/8</u>" spikes maximum are allowed. Concessions and t-shirts will be sold at the meet. We do not permit dogs on school grounds at any time and ask that you **share this with your athletes and parents prior to competition**. Please have well labeled starting blocks to avoid lost or stolen equipment.

**Parking:** There is plenty of room in the high school parking lot for cars. Buses must park in the bus loop after the team is dropped off. They can enter driveway C and proceed left to the loop.

**Entries**: We are working on a simple entry registration by use of Trackqua. David Reinhardt will be running the meet and will let me know when registration opens. Entries will be required by Wednesday, May 1st with final changes due Friday, May 3rd at noon. The meet will not be re-seeded. Coaches, please include an e-mail address for contact purposes. We ask that changes the day of the meet be done only in an **extreme circumstance**. There will be no additions on the day of the meet.
