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#### **ENTRY INFORMATION:**

Enter all hurdlers (100, 110, and 400 H) on individual cards. Any team that submits hurdlers any other way will not be seeded properly. Field relays are entered via email by Thursday 4/18 (7pm deadline).

#### SCORING:

Scoring will be 10-8-6-4-2-1

Frosh-soph races will be non-scoring.

Team trophies to 1<sup>st</sup> place boys team and 1<sup>st</sup> place girls team.

1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> varsity relays receive medals

1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> frosh-soph receive medals

#### **POLICIES**

- 1. NYS Jewelry & uniform rules are in effect.
- 2. Spikes are permitted (1/4" or less)
- 3. Please bring your own starting blocks
- 4. Teams should camp outside the track
- 5. Only coaches and athletes are permitted inside the track area.
- 6. A concession stand will be available as well as T-shirts.

# FIELD EVENTS (4 throws/jumps)

REMEMBER: all field entries are submitted to <a href="mailto:stillwatertrack@yahoo.com">stillwatertrack@yahoo.com</a> by 4/18 (7pm)

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SHOT – girls first (4 throws)

DISC – boys first (4 throws)

JAVELIN (located on far field behind the "away bleachers") – girls first (4 throws)

LONG (located near discus) – girls first (4 jumps)

TRIP (located near shot) – boys first (4 jumps)

HIGH – girls first

POLE – boys first
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In all the field events, the top two competitors from each school combine to make a team score.

## HOW TIES WILL BE MANAGED:

In the case of a tie, the best mark by best athlete per school breaks tie. If tie remains, then go to the best mark of the second athlete. If tie remains go to the best mark of the third. If tie remains it remains a tie.
